

Works Notice Blayney MPS Redevelopment

11 February 2025

Temporary hydraulic and electrical works: 12 – 28 February 2025

Health Infrastructure is building the Blayney MPS Redevelopment to provide high quality health and aged care services closer to home, in a modern facility which will continue to meet local health care needs for years to come.

Health Infrastructure has engaged Taylor Construction to carry out the work, which is being completed in stages. Stage 1 works, the construction of the new Residential Aged Care wing and Inpatient Unit, is now underway.

This notice is to inform that there will be temporary hydraulic and electrical supply works taking place on the site from **Wednesday 12 February until Friday 28 February 2025.** Power supply will not be affected.

These works include:

- Installation of exclusion zone fencing and signage.
- Delivery and unloading of materials to the designated work area.
- Installation of cable ladders, including across rooftop between two buildings (see pic on right). Warning flags will be erected under the cable ladder.
- Installation of cables.
- Isolation and connection to existing Main Switch Board.


Work times will be between 7.00am and

5.00pm on weekdays in accordance with

planning approvals. We will let you know in advance of any changes to these days and times.

How will the work affect you?

- There will be no direct impacts to MPS operations, including no loss of power.
- All works will take place externally except for when the contractors will walk through the MPS to investigate existing services, placing ladders to access ceiling panels.
- Partial closure of emergency side entrance to install ladder access to Emergency will be maintained for emergency vehicles at all times. Ambulance NSW has been notified.



We recognise that building new infrastructure can be disruptive to staff, residents, patients, neighbours, nearby businesses and road users. All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority.
